

# The sense of metaphysics/ontology. Object, method, concept, grounds, criticism Conference Terms and Conditions

§ ]

- 1. These Terms and Conditions (hereinafter: Terms) set forth the rules of participation in *The sense of metaphysics/ontology. Object, method, concept, grounds, criticism* Scientific Conference (hereinafter: Conference), the purpose of which is to exchange ideas about the rationality of philosophical research on general theories of reality.
- 2. The topics of the Conference include the object, method, concept, grounds, criticism of metaphysics/ontology, as well as other metaquestions related to these fields of philosophy.

#### **General Provisions**

§ 2

- 1. The organizer of the Conference is the University of Occupational Safety Management in Katowice, 8 Bankowa Street, 40-007 Katowice (hereinafter: Organizer / WSZOP).
- 2. The Conference will be held on **June 6-7, 2024** in a hybrid form, i.e. at the WSZOP headquarters and via the TEAMS platform.
- 3. The conference will be held in Polish and English.
- 4. The substantive patronage of the Conference is provided by:

## Terms of participation

§ 3

There are three forms of participation in the Conference:

- 1) participation with presentation of a paper (presenter)
- 2) participation without a paper (listener)
- 3) submission of an article for publication

§ 4

The condition for participation in the Conference is:

- 1) completion of the online registration form by April 30, 2024.
- 2) payment of the conference fee by May 7, 2024 in cases referred to in § 7
- 3) receiving confirmation of registration from the Organizer
- 4) acceptance of the Terms and Conditions

§ 5

- 1. After receiving the topics of the papers, the Organizer will qualify the papers for the corresponding problem sections.
- 2. The Organizer reserves the right to select and reject papers.

§ 6

- 1. The time allotted for the speaker's speech is 30 minutes (30 minutes/paper + 15 minutes/discussion).
- 2. The organizer provides an opportunity to submit a scientific article to be published in the post-conference monograph. The conditions for acceptance of the article are: sending the article to filozofia@wszop.edu.pl, providing a statement of authorship by **September 30, 2024**, obtaining a positive review, and meeting the editorial requirements (available on the wszop.edu.pl/o-editorial website).
- 3. Articles qualified for publication in the post-conference monograph must not exceed the volume (20-40 thousand characters with spaces).

#### **Payments**

- 1. Fees for participation in the Conference are:
  - 1) in person presenter **35** €
  - 2) online presenter 25 €
  - 3) in person listener **35** €
  - 4) submission of an article for publication -35 €

- 3. The Organizer will issue an invoice for the fees associated with the Conference with data provided by the Participant in the application form.

§ 8

- 1. The Organizer shall provide simultaneous interpretation of the speeches.
- 2. The Organizer issues certificates of participation in the Conference (paper-based for participating in person and electronic for online participants).

§ 9

- 1. The Organizer shall provide online Participants with technical assistance during the Conference via e-mail or telephone.
- 2. An invitation to participate containing a link to the Conference will be sent to the e-mail address provided by the Participant no later than 24 hours before the start of the Conference.
- 3. The Organizer shall not be liable for technical or organizational problems of the Participants related to the participation in the Conference resulting from causes beyond their control.
- 4. The Participant is obliged to mark their participation in the Conference by providing their full name and the represented institution.

§ 10

The Organizer provides the in person Participants with:

- 3) public Internet access.

## Cancellation of participation in the Conference

§ 11

- 1. The Participant may resign from participation in the Conference only by sending appropriate information to the filozofia@wszop.edu.pl e-mail address.
- 2. The Participant shall be entitled to a refund of the paid Conference fee if they notify the Organizer of their resignation by **May 15, 2024** using the filozofia@wszop.edu.pl e-mail address and they get a confirmation from the Organizer or if their paper topic is rejected by the Scientific Committee.
- 3. The participant is entitled to a refund of the paid fee for the publication of the article in the post-conference monograph if they notify the Organizer of their resignation by **June 30, 2024** using the filozofia@wszop.edu.pl e-mail address, if their submitted topic is rejected by the Organizing Committee or if the article obtains a negative review.
